

Achievements

Over six years we have achieved

1. We have continued to maintain our position in the best 10% for risk adjusted mortality
2. 96% reduction in MRSA blood stream infections
3. 90% reduction in C-Difficile infections
4. 59% reduction in cardiac arrests

2012-13 achievements:

5. 22% decrease in weekend mortality
6. 97.7% of patients receive harm free care
7. 46% reduction in Grade 2 pressure ulcers across the Trust
8. 88% reduction in Grade 3 and 4 pressure ulcers across the Trust
9. 44% reduction in catheter associated urinary tract infections (In pilot areas)
10. 96% of patients have VTE risk assessment completed
11. 68% increase in recognition of sepsis
12. Wait times for the Intestinal Failure Service decreased by 39%
13. 16% Decrease in orthopaedic surgical site infections
